What is Balloon Sinuplasty? It is a safe and effective sinus procedure for chronic sinusitis patients seeking relief from uncomfortable sinus pain symptoms. Some people suffer from constant sinus infections, congestion, pressure and headaches, and while medications provide temporary relief, the suffering from these chronic conditions leaves them not only fatigued and in pain, but also frustrated. Many of these people have opted out of surgery due to concern of postoperative pain and/or recovery time. These were valid concerns given the historical need to remove tissue to achieve sinus treatment goals. But recent advancements in balloon sinus dilation technology have allowed for this alternative, safe and effective treatment that is minimally invasive – no cutting of nasal bone or tissue.

How does it work? The devices we use are flexible instruments that allow us to restore normal drainage and function while preserving your natural anatomy. It uses guide wires and balloon dilation of bone and soft tissue to open the natural sinus outflow tracts with minimal injury, speeding recovery for patients. Because of the remodeling of bone, a durable permanent opening is created in the sinus ostium.

How long does recovery take? While recovery time varies with each patient, recovery is usually fast. Typically, most patients can return to work and normal activity within two days.

Am I a candidate? If you've been diagnosed with chronic sinusitis and are not responding well to medication, or if you have recurrent acute rhinosinusitis, you may be a candidate for Balloon Sinuplasty. Chronic symptoms include:

- Facial pain and pressure
- Nasal congestion & blockage
- Post nasal drainage
- Headaches
- Nasal discharge
- Tooth pain
- Loss of smell or taste
- Fatigue
